General Information

The Eumetcal 2 Program is The EUMETNET Education and Training Collaborative Network of the National Meteorological Services within Europe. Eumetcal's role is to support this community in sharing material and courses, in order to increase the education and training opportunities for its members. .

The recent COVID-19 outbreak and the associated changes to the way we work has added an extra dimension to this. At this moment we are at a point that members need to invest in order to transpose classroom training into online curriculum as an answer to the members' challenge of keep their education and training program running. Eumetcal wants to support its members in this process and is building an (international team of experts to build an online education and training program accessible to all Eumetcal members.

Job Description

As an instructional designer you will enhance the didactical and pedagogical knowledge and skills of our network by educating and training the people responsible for meteorological education and training within EUMETNET.

You will advise on the best design of effective (online) training resources and courses that can be re-used for other purposes.

Collaborating within a team of experts, you will set up a Eumetcal Expertise Centre. This Eumetcal Expertise Centre will be a virtual platform for training and continuous development of trainers in the field of meteorology, climatology and hydrology. The Expertise Centre will also be the place where the members can find answers on, for example, all their questions relating to (re)use of existing material and tips-and-tricks related to preparing new material.

You will work in a team with the Programme Manager, an Instructional Designer from the COMET Programme and the Technical Support Officer.

Required

- You have a bachelor or master's degree in educational sciences or a related field and have clear vision on how online education and training methods can be used in the most efficient way.
- You have experience in designing successful online educational programs and platforms.
- You bring people together, both within and outside the Eumetcal Community to meet the E&T Goals of our member's organizations.

- You like to teach the members from the Eumetcal Community the knowledge and skills from your field of expertise and help to apply it in their daily work.
- You have a pro-active and result oriented attitude and skills to timely manage your work to guarantee the progress of the project;
- You have excellent English communication skills to work smoothly in an international environment and the flexibility to deal with different time zones.
- Experience in the field of Meteorology is desirable but not required.

Details:

Part-time (18 hours per week) temporary position till the end of 2023.

Candidates should be employed by one of the EUMETNET institutes, and their application should have the support of this host institute. The remuneration level of the successful candidate will correspond to that of an Instructional Designer in the host institute as decided by its General Director and should be suitable within the allocated budget for this position.
